

Ways to Give

Giving by Texting

1. In the To: type the phone number 951-420-6909
2. In the Text Message: type Give and the amount. (enter the number in one of these ways 50, \$50, 50.00. You can use the number sign or not.). It works either way. If you change your mind or make a mistake you just need to type “refund 50”, make sure it is the amount you put in. Then you can start over. You will receive a confirmation email each time.
3. If it is the first time you are donating by text, you will be given a link and asked to supply your payment method (credit card, debit card, or bank account). This payment source will then be linked with your phone number so, in the future, all you need to do is text in the amount and you do not need to re-enter your payment information again, unless you need to change it.
4. You will receive a text in response confirming your tithe or gift has been received successfully.
5. You may also use: \$(amount) Ministry Student, \$(amount) Unexpected Income, etc.
